Business Need

Jeff needs an internet-based application that tracks his to-do items.

Functionality

1. **Individuals shall be able to register by using an email address and password**
2. Individuals shall be able to unregister
3. Individuals shall be able to reset a forgotten password
4. Individuals shall be able to log into the system by using a registered email and password
5. Individuals shall be able to create to-do items
6. Individuals shall be able to view their to-do items as a list, each to-do item has a count-down timer that shows the time left
7. Individuals shall be able to view a list of items pending
8. Individuals shall be able to reassign to-do items
9. Individuals shall be able to accept or reject to-do items assigned to them
10. Individuals shall be able to view a to-do item
11. Individuals shall be able to assign existing to-do items to other registered individuals
12. Individuals shall be able to mark to-do items complete
13. Individuals shall be able to delete to-do items
14. Individuals shall be able to update to-do items

Expected Value

Tangible: Jeff and others will be able to use and plan their time more effectively.

Intangible: Jeff and others will have peace of mind knowing that they would not have forgotten things that they have to do.

1. User Story - Register for an Account

Story:	<i>As an unregistered user, I want to register for an account, so that I can track my to-do items.</i>

Post-Conditions:	<i>I am now a registered user.</i>

Trigger:	<p>Trigger Type: External</p> <p><i>I use a browser to navigate to the login page: [server]/countdown/Login/ or [server]/countdown/Login/index.html.</i></p>

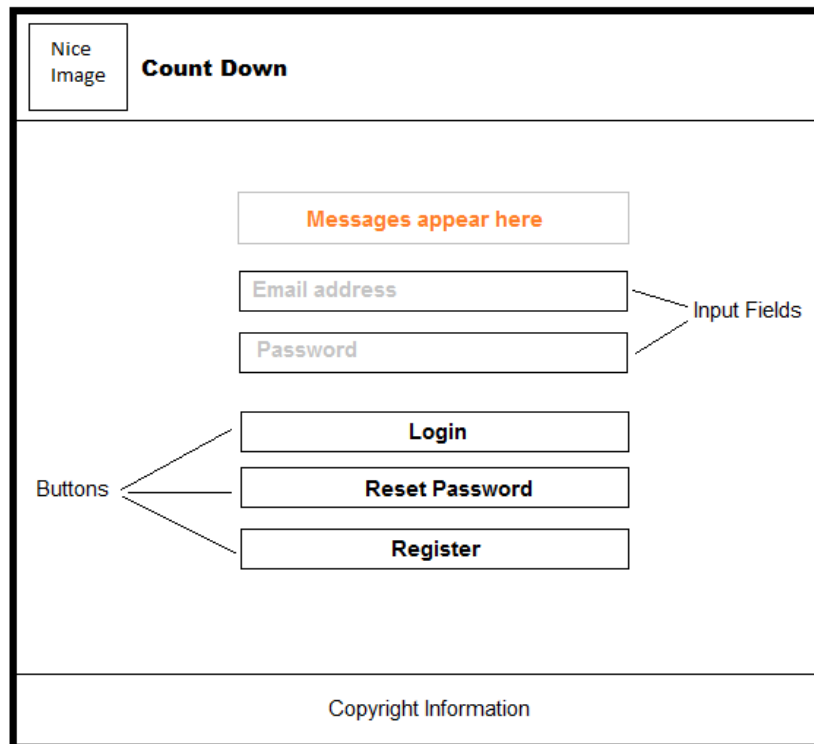


Figure 1(Login)

Normal Flow of Events:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Countdown displays the login page (See Figure 1). 2. I issue the 'Register' command. 3. Countdown displays the registration page: [server]/countdown/register/ (See Figure 2) 4. I enter registration data into the fields: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. <First name> ::= ¹{<any alphanumeric character>}⁵⁰ b. <Last name> ::= ⁰{<any alphanumeric character>}⁵⁰ c. <Email> ::= Standard email address as outlined here: http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Email_address d. <Reenter email> ::= <Email> e. <Password> ::= ⁴{<any alphanumeric character>}⁵⁰ <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i. Displayed as password dots f. <Reenter password> ::= <Password> 5. I issue the 'Submit' command (See Alternative: Page Alternative Flows). 6. Countdown validates my input (See Exception: Validation) 7. Countdown saves my data (See Exception: Unexpected Error). 8. Countdown displays the login page with a 'Registration successful' message and my email in the email address field.

Alternative/Exception flows:

1. **Alternative: Page Alternative Flows**
 - i. If I click the **Login** link at any time, Countdown displays the login page.
 - ii. If I issue the **Clear** command, the input fields are cleared.
2. **Exception: Validation**
 - i. If the first name is invalid then "The first name must be from 1 to 50 characters in length" is displayed next to the first name field.
 - ii. If the last name is invalid then "The last name must be from 0 to 50 characters in length" is displayed next to the last name field.
 - iii. If the email address format is not standard then "Please enter a valid email address" is displayed next to the email field.
 - iv. If the reenter email does not match the email then "Emails do not match" is displayed next to the reenter email field.
 - v. If the password is invalid then "The password must be from 4 to 50 characters in length" is displayed next to the password field.
 - vi. If the reenter password does not match the password then "Passwords do not match" is displayed next to the reenter password field.
3. **Exception: Unexpected Error**
 - i. If an unexpected exception is thrown then Countdown displays the system error page (see Figure 3). **This is applicable to all pages.**
